Frequently Asked Questions

Is a deposit required to reserve my wedding date?

A deposit of \$349 is required at the time of securing a contract and reserving your wedding date. The remainder of the balance is due 30 days prior to the wedding.

My wedding isn't for (12, 15, 18) months. Why should I reserve my date now?

The most obvious answer is that you should reserve your date now because it may not be available a few months down the road. Most of my weddings are booked 6 to 12 months in advance. An added benefit of booking early is that you protect yourself against any future increase in the package prices.

Who will record and edit my wedding?

Your wedding will be recorded and edited by me, Dennis Duszynski. I will occasionally bring a qualified assistant to help me on your wedding day. I do not contract out work to other people under any circumstances.

Do you have any time restrictions?

Absolutely not! I will arrive at your wedding site when you do (for package 3 or 4), and leave the reception when you leave (for packages 2, 3 or 4). The day is yours!

What type of equipment do you use?

All of my wedding packages include 2 camera coverage (*Sony HDR-FX1000*) during the ceremony and a single camera during the reception. To ensure high-quality audio reproduction, a wireless lapel microphone is used during the ceremony and is placed on the groom in a discreet location. Wireless microphones are also available for musicians, readers, etc. during the ceremony. I use a computerized non-linear editing system to capture, edit, and master your video to DVD.

Will my wedding be recorded in high definition?

I use high definition cameras for all of my weddings. If you would like your wedding recorded in HD and rendered to Blu-ray discs, please see my packages for current pricing.

Do you attend the wedding rehearsal?

Yes, I make every effort to come to Friday evening wedding rehearsals at no extra charge. This gives me the chance to meet the wedding coordinator, clergy, and bridal party in advance of the wedding day. It also allows me the opportunity to discuss camera locations and any last minute details with the bride and groom.

How long will my wedding video be?

All weddings are different, but in general, you should expect your completed documentary-style dvd including the complete ceremony and all of the reception festivities to be between 60 and 90 minutes long. The best way to get a feel for my shooting and editing style is to request a full-length sample dvd.

When will my DVDs be ready?

It generally takes 4-6 weeks to complete your DVDs.
